

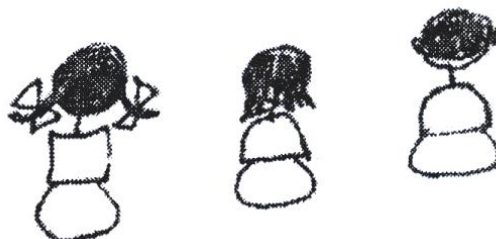
**Our Lives Are God's,

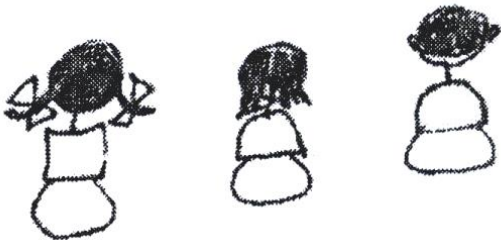

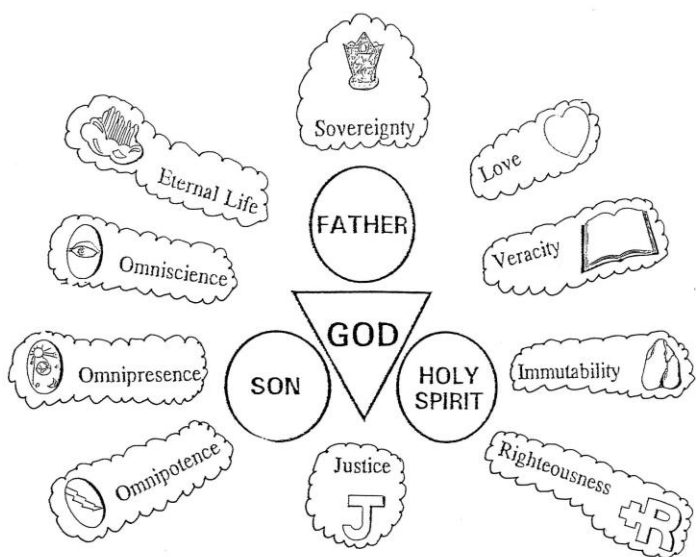

### God's Divine Nature

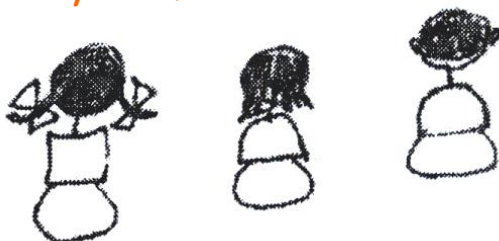


When we come to truly love God, others will know it by our daily lives and we will want to tell others about Him so they can know and enjoy Him also. This too brings glory to God.

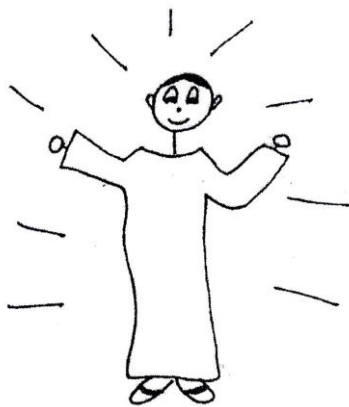

*Romans 10:17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.*

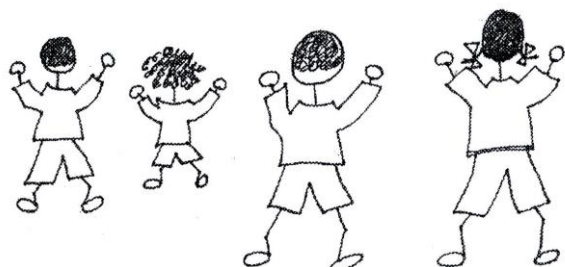

There is a huge difference between thinking that we are the cause of changes in our spiritual life - and knowing that the cause of our changes are because we are in Christ. Christ now lives in us and so does the Holy Spirit. We can't fix or make better the desires of the flesh. Instead, God the Holy Spirit will be using His power to change us; He will substitute the things of the Spirit and of Christ for the things of the flesh. God will change us! **He gives us time so He can change us!**

*Philippians 2:13 For it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.*



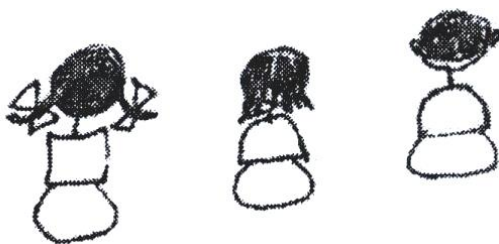


The Holy Spirit will substitute the thoughts of Christ for the thoughts of the flesh. He will substitute God's will for our will, His desires for our desires and His plans for our plans. The Holy Spirit wants to change our thinking about our ambitions - giving us new goals, resources and hopes. He will substitute God's love for our fear. We can't change ourselves; the world tells us that we can. Wrong! **We need God the Holy Spirit to change us!**
