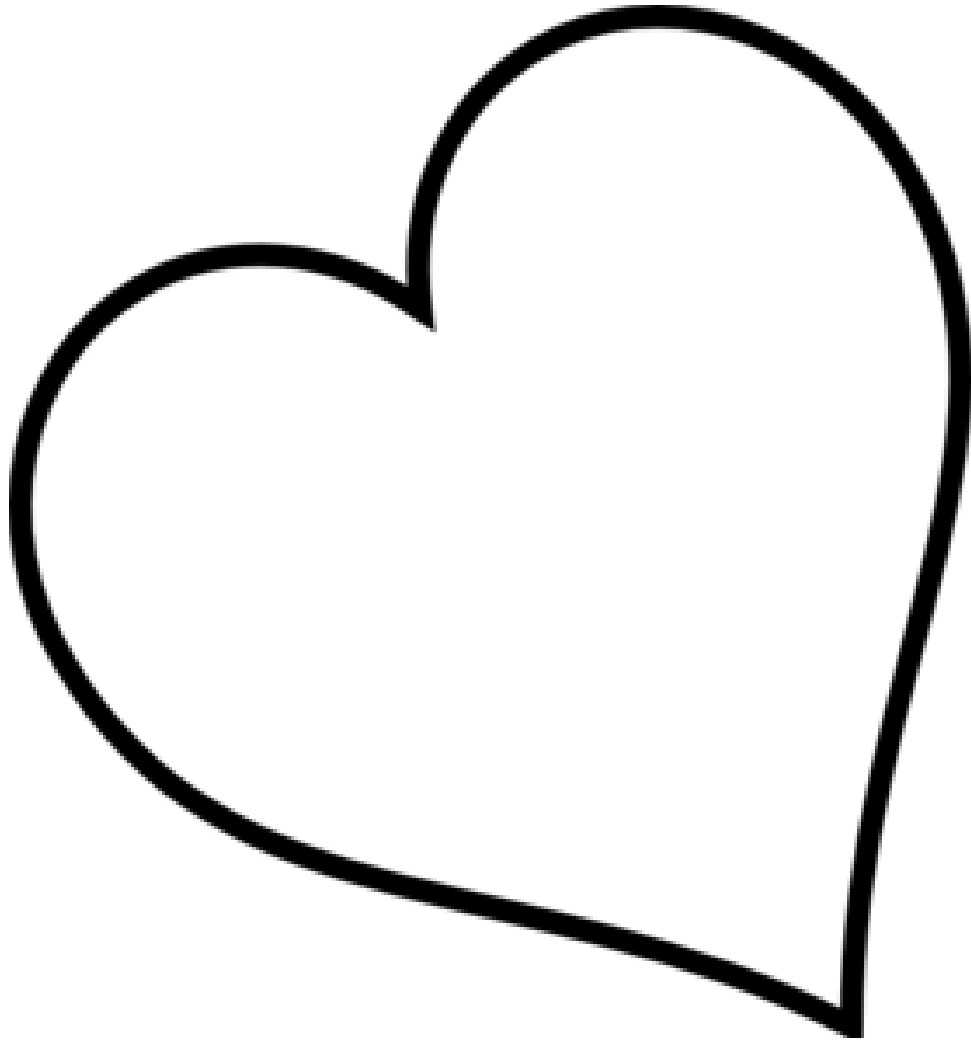


What's In Your Heart?

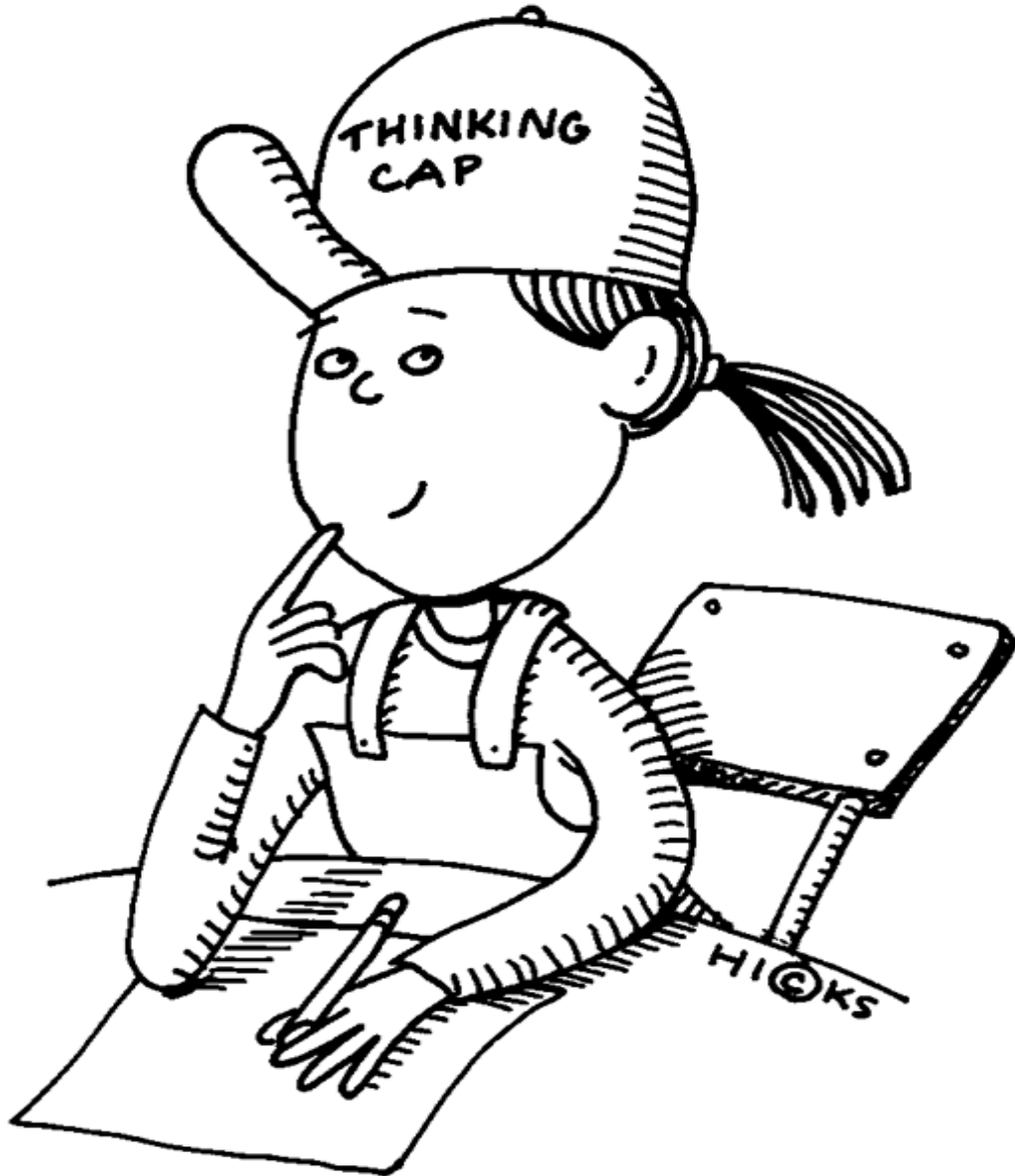


In the Bible, your mind is also called your heart.

What you think you usually say and do.



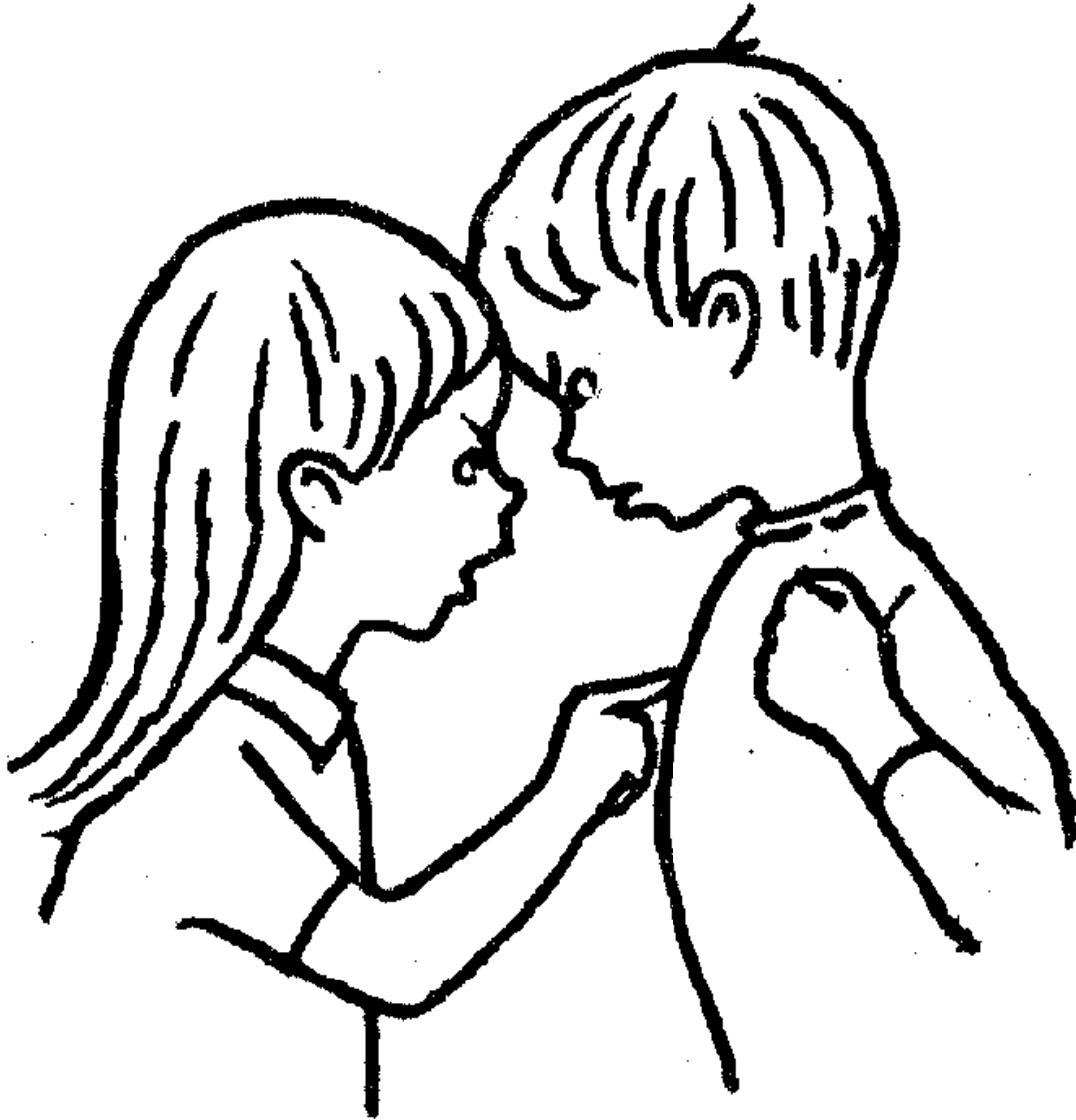
James 1:19-20 But everyone must be quick to hear, slow to speak *and* slow to anger; for the anger of man does not achieve the righteousness of God.

If you are thinking good thoughts, you will say and do good things.



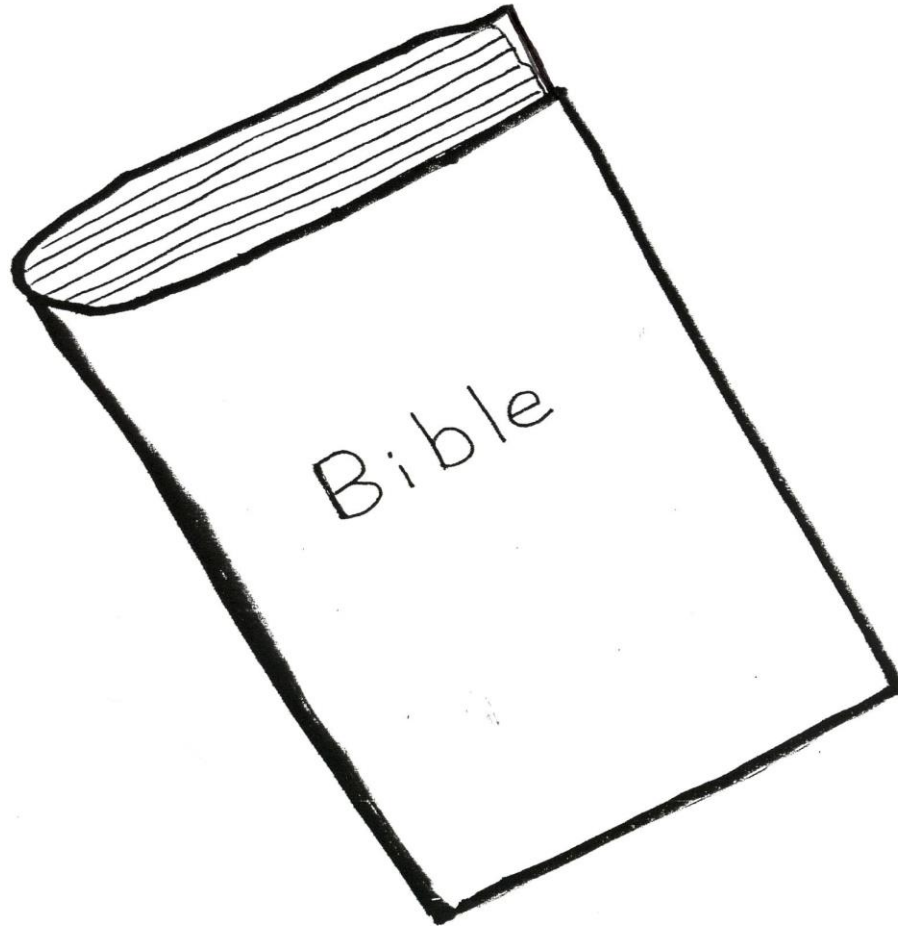

you will say and do bad things.



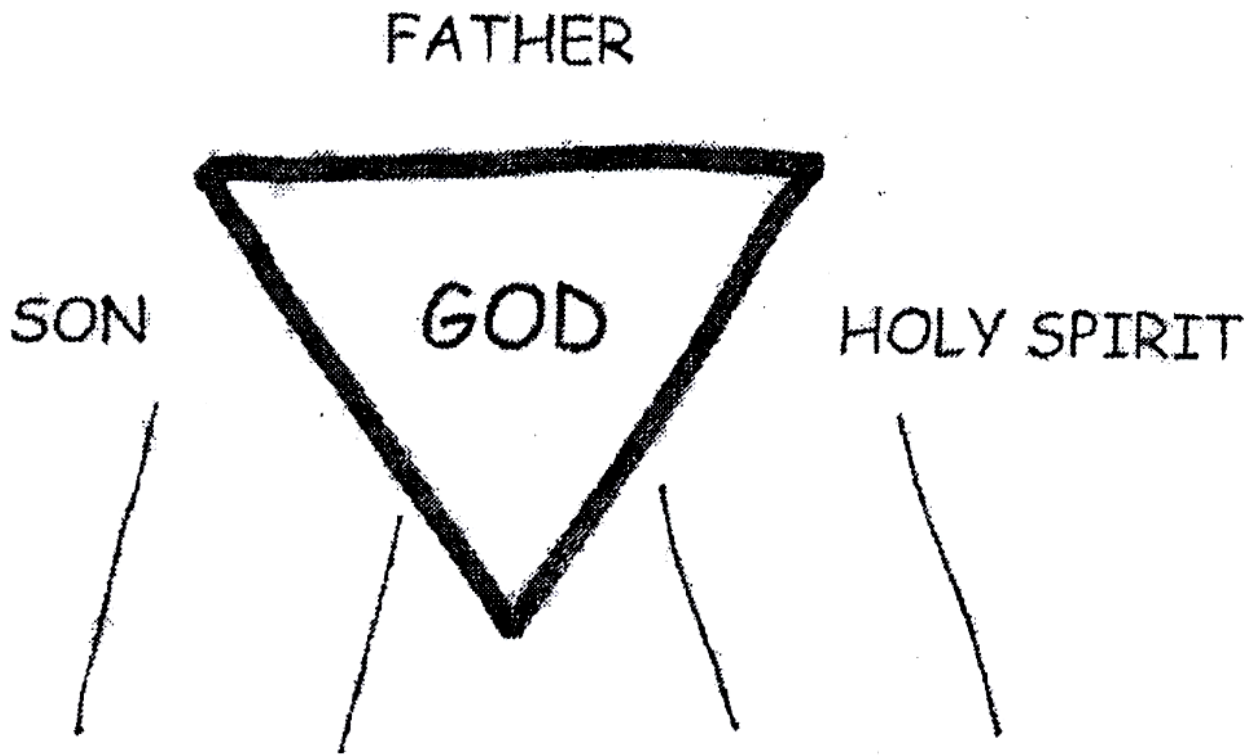
Galatians 5:26 Let us not become boastful, challenging one another, envying one another.

Christ in the Bible!



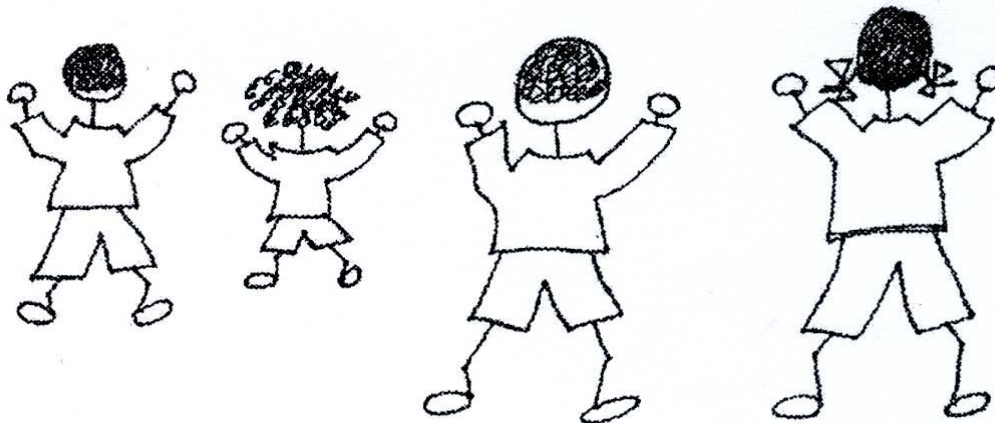

Jesus Christ is God so His thoughts are God's thoughts!



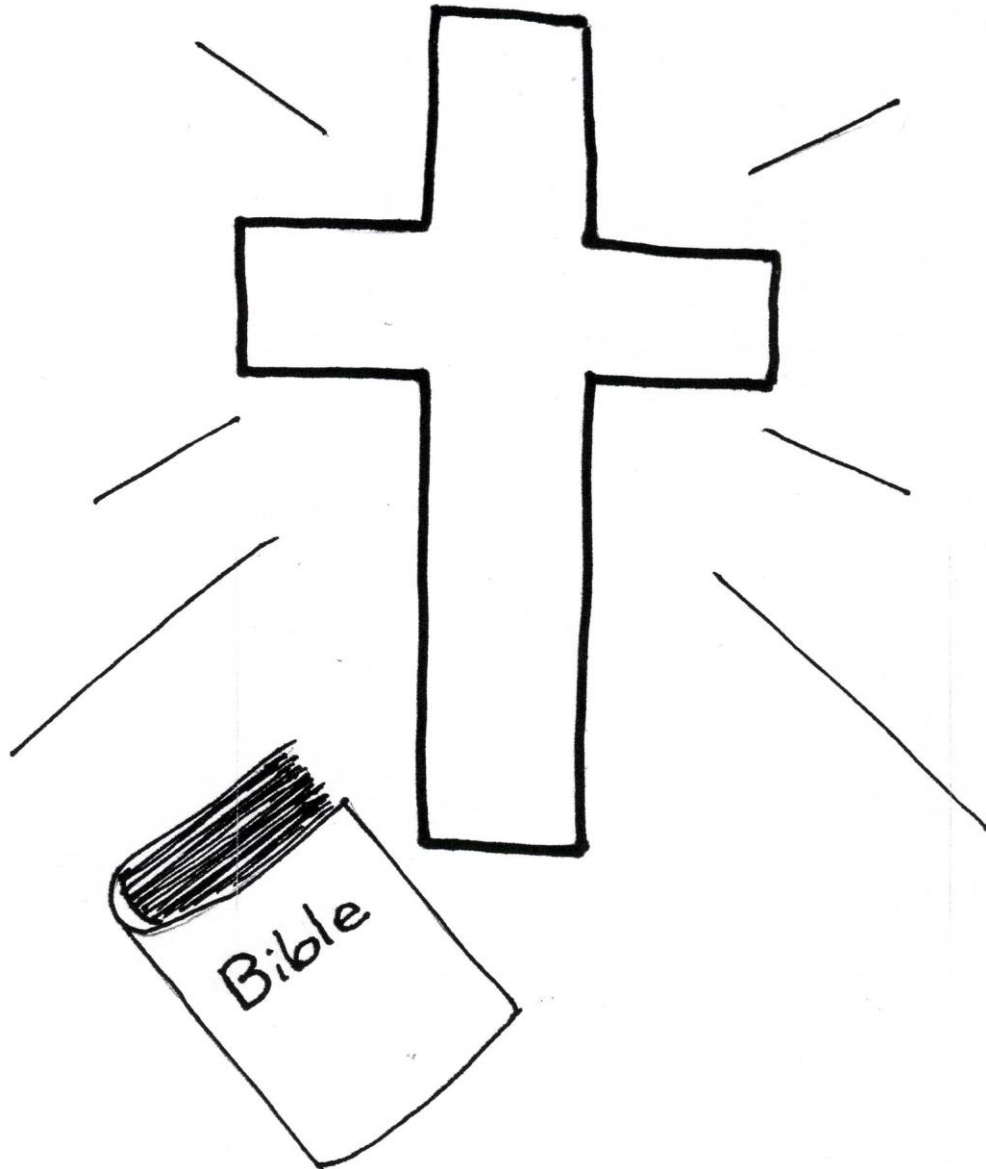
James 3:17 But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, reasonable, full of mercy and good fruits, unwavering, without hypocrisy.
